Vocab

General Meaning

Staying away from doubtful matters which leads a Muslim to have honor and free from criticism

Points of Benefit

- A Muslim should be certain of every act he performs. If there's any doubt, he should leave that act
- In At-Tirmidzi's version, there is an additional phrase: "The truth brings tranquility while falsehood sows doubt". Engaging in things that is clear cut will lead to true happiness here and hereafter
- There are 2 types of outcomes:
 - The one's that breeds doubt Musytabihat
 - The ones that is clear Halal Haram
- The is no goodness in avoiding something that is clearly permissible
- Examples of leaving things that is doubtful
