

INTRODUCTION

When an epidemic spreads over multiple countries and continents, it becomes a pandemic. Islam is a complete system of life that gives us the solutions for our every need. This includes what to do during a disease outbreak like Covid-19.



EPIDEMIC: AN ISLAMIC PERSPECTIVE

From Aisyah (), wife of The Prophet (), she said: "I asked Allah's Messenger () about the plague. He told me that it was a punishment sent by Allah on whom he wished, and Allah made it a source of mercy for the believers, for if one in the time of an epidemic plague stays in his country (or in his house) patiently hoping for Allah's Reward and believing that nothing will befall him except what Allah has written for him, he will get the reward of a martyr."






General Preventive Supplications (no specific time)

The supplication of Dhun-Nun (Prophet Yunus) لَا إِلَهَ إِلَا أَنتَ سُبحَـٰنَكَ إِنِّي كُنتُ مِنَ الظَّلِمِينَ

Lā ilāha illā anta subḥānaka innī kuntu minaẓ-ẓālimīn "There is none worthy of worship except You, Glory to You, Indeed, I have been of the transgressors."

Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) said: "So indeed, no Muslim man supplicates with it for anything, ever, except Allah responds to him." [Sunan At-Tirmidzi no. 3505]



Say, "I seek refuge in the Lord of mankind, The Sovereign of mankind. The God of mankind, From the evil of the retreating whisperer - Who whispers [evil] into the breasts of mankind - From among the jinn and mankind." [An-Nas: 1- 6]

Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) said: "No one ever sought refuge (with Allah) by means of anything like them." *[Sunan An-Nasaa'i no. 5429]*

Seeking Refuge with Allah



Allahumma inni a'udhu bika minal-barasi, wal- jununi, wal-judhami, wa sayyi'il-asqami'

"O Allah, I seek refuge in You from leprosy, madness, elephantiasis, and evil diseases."

The Prophet (ﷺ) used to say it. [Sunan Abi Daud no. 1554]

Seeking Refuge with Allah اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِن زَوَالِ نِعْمَتِكَ وَتَحَوُّلِ عَافِيَتِكَ وَفُجَاءَةِ نِقْمَتِكَ وَبَحَمِيعِ سَخَطِكِ Allahumma inni a'udhu bika min zawali ni'matika, wa tahawwuli 'afiyatika, wa fuja'ati nigmatika, wa jami'i sakhatika

"O Allah! I seek refuge in You from the withholding of Your favour, the decline of the good health you have given, the suddenness of Your vengeance and from all forms of Your wrath."

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) used to supplicate this. [Sahih Muslim no. 5739]

Asking For Goodness From Allah

اللَّهُمَّ رَبَّنَا آتِنَا فِي الدُّنْيَا حَسَنَةً وَفِي الآخِرَةِ حَسَنَةً وَقِنَا عَذَابَ النَّارِ

Allahumma Rabbanaa 'aatinaa fid-dunyaa hasanatan wa fil-'aakhirati hasanatan wa qinaa 'athaaban-naar.

"O Allah! Our Lord! Give us in this world that, which is good and in the Hereafter that which is good and save us from the torment of the Fire."

> The most frequent invocation of The Prophet (ﷺ). [Sahih Al-Bukhari no. 6389]

Supplication for One in Distress



Allaahumma rahmataka 'arjoo falaa takilnee 'ilaa nafsee tarfata 'aynin, wa 'aslih lee sha'nee kullahu, laa'ilaaha 'illaa 'Anta.

"O Allah! Thy mercy is what I hope for. Do not abandon me to myself for an instant, but put all my affairs in good order for me. There is no god but You."

The Prophet (ﷺ) taught this supplication to be used by one who is distressed. [Sahih Al-Bukhari no. 6389]



Supplication During Difficulty



Laa 'ilaaha 'illallaahul-'Adheemul-Haleem, laa 'ilaaha 'illallaahu Rabbul-'Arshil-'Adheem, laa 'ilaaha 'illallaahu Rabbus-samaawaati wa Rabbul-'ardhi wa Rabbul-'Arshil-Kareem

There is none worthy of worship but Allah the Mighty, the Forbearing. There is none worthy of worship but Allah, Lord of the Magnificent Throne. There is none worthy of worship but Allah, Lord of the heavens and Lord of the earth, and Lord of the Noble Throne.

The Prophet (ﷺ) used to say this at the time of difficulty. [Sahih Al-Bukhari no. 7431]

Specific Preventive Supplications (recited at designated times)

Ask Allah for Sufficiency (once every night)

The Messenger has believed in what was revealed to him from his Lord, and [so have] the believers. All of them have believed in Allah and His angels and His books and His messengers, [saying], "We make no distinction between any of His messengers." And they say, "We hear and we obey. [We seek] Your forgiveness, our Lord, and to You is the [final] destination". Allah does not charge a soul except [with that within] its capacity. It will have [the consequence of] what [good] it has gained, and it will bear [the consequence of] what [good] it has gained, and it will bear [the consequence of] what [evil] it has earned. "Our Lord, do not impose blame upon us if we have forgotten or erred. Our Lord, and lay not upon us a burden like that which You laid upon those before us. Our Lord, and burden us not with that which we have no ability to bear. And pardon us; and forgive us; and have mercy upon us. You are our protector, so give us victory over the disbelieving people." [Al-Baqarah: 285-286]

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said: "Two verses at the end of Surah al-Baqarah, anyone who recites them at night, they would suffice for him." [Sahih Al-Bukhari no. 5009 and Sahih Muslim no. 807]

Saying During Distress

اللهُ اللهُ رَبِّي لَا أُشْرِكُ بِهِ شَيْئًا

Allaahu Allaahu Rabbee laa 'ushriku bihishay'an

"Allah, Allah is my Lord. I do not associate anything with Him."

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said: May I not teach you phrases which you utter in distress? [Sunan Abi Daud no. 1525]

Ask for Well-Being and Protection: (once in the morning and once in the evening)

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ الْعَافِيَةَ فِي الدُّنْيَا وَالآخِرَةِ اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ الْعَفْوَ وَالْعَافِيَةَ فِي دِينِي وَدُنْيَايَ وَأَهْلِي وَمَالِي اللَّهُمَّ اسْتُرْ عَوْرَاتِي وَآمِنْ رَوْعَاتِي اللَّهُمَّ احْفَظْنِي مِنْ بَيْنَ يَدَيَّ وَمِنْ خَلْغِي وَعَنْ يَمِينِي وَعَنْ شِمَالِي وَمِنْ فَوْقِي وَأَعُوذُ بِعَظَمَتِكَ أَنْ أُغْتَالَ مِنْ تَحْقِي

Allāhumma innī as'aluka `āfiyata fid-dunyā wal-ākhirati, Allāhumma innī as'aluka 'l-`afwa wal-`āfiyata fī dīnī wa dunyaaya wa ahlī, wa mālī, Allāhummastur `awrātī, wa āmin raw'ātī, Allāhummaḥfaẓnī min bayni yadayya, wa min khalfī, wa `an yamīnī, wa `an shimālī, wa min fawqī, wa a`oodhu bi`aẓamatika an 'ughtāla min tahtī.

"O Allah, I ask you for well-being in this world and the Next. O Allah, I ask you for forgiveness and well-being in my deen and in this world and in my family and my property. O Allah, veil my faults and calm my fears. O Allah, give me protection in front of me and behind me, on my right and my left and above me. I seek refuge by Your might from being overwhelmed from under me."

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) never failed to utter these supplications in the evening and in the morning. [Sunan Abi Daud no. 5074]

Protection from Harm (three times in the morning and three times in the evening)

بِسْمِ اللهِ الَّذِي لَا يَضُرُّ مَعَ اسْمِهِ شَيْءٌ فِي الْأَرْضِ وَلَا فِي السَّمَاءِ وَهُوَ السَّمِيعُ الْعَلِيمُ

Bismillāh, alladhi lā yadurru ma`a ismihi shai'un fil-ardi wa lā fis-samā', wa huwas-Samī`ul `Alīm

"In the Name of Allah, Who with His Name nothing can cause harm in the earth nor in the heavens, and He is the All-Hearing, the All-Knowing."

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said: "There is no worshiper who says it, in the morning of every day, and the evening of every night, (except that) nothing shall harm him." [Sunan Abi Daud no. 5088]

Seeking Refuge with the Perfect Word of Allah (once in the evening)

أَعُوذُ بِحَلِمَاتِ اللهِ التَّامَّاتِ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا خَلَقَ

'A'udhu bikalimatillahit-tammati min sharri ma khalaqa

I seek refuge in the Perfect Words of Allah from the evil of what He has created.

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said: "Had you recited these words in the evening: ... it would not have done any harm to you. *[Sahih Muslim no. 2708]*

Asking from Allah Security, Safety, Protection & Screen

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُك بِنُورِ وَجْهِك الَّذِي أَشْرَقَتْ لَهُ السَّمَاوَاتُ وَالْأَرْضُ أَنْ تَجْعَلَنِي فِي حِرْزِك وَحِفْظِك وَجِوَارِك وَتَحْتَ كَنَفِك

Allaahumma inni as'alu-Ka binur wajhi-Ka allazi asyraqat lahu as-samaawaatu wa al-ardhu an taj'alani fi hirzi-Ka, wa hifzi-Ka, wa jiwaari-Ka wa tahta kanafi-Ka

"Oh God, I ask you by the light of Your face, towards which the heavens and the earth shine, to put us in Your security, Your safety, Your protection, and under Your screen"

A person can also protect himself from a disease by taking supplements mentioned in the Sunnah or Health Research that can boost up his immune system, such as:







SOCIAL DISTANCING ACCORDING TO THE HADITH



Allahs Messenger (ﷺ) said, "(There is) no 'Adwa (transmitting disease), nor is there any bad omen (from birds), nor is there any Hamah, nor is there any bad omen in the month of Safar, and one should run away from the leper as one runs away from the lion."

[Sahih Al-Bukhari no. 5707]

قَالَ رَسُولُ اللهِ ﷺ : لَا عَدْوَى وَلَا طِيَرَةَ وَلَا هَامَةَ وَلَا صَفَرَ وَفِرَّ مِنَ الْمَجْذُومِ كَمَا تَفِرُّ مِنَ الْأَسَدِ

What the Prophet (ﷺ) said really meant by saying: "No transmitting disease" is that "no contagious disease is conveyed without Allah's permission". This can be understood from his command at the end of the hadith: **"and you should run away from the leper as you run away from the lion"**, indicating it is a Sunnah to avoid diseases and infected patients.

Methods of disease transmission

There are many ways that diseases can be passed from person to person, and some diseases can be transmitted in more than one way. Sometimes transmission involves direct contact with an infected person, while other times it only requires being near an infected person. Some diseases are not even spread through contact with people at all, but through contact with animals.



Direct transmission means that the disease is passed directly from one infected person or animal to another person or animal

1. PERSON-TO-PERSON



Person-to-person transmission can occur anytime an infected person touches or exchanges body fluids with another person. For example, kissing can be one method of person-to-person transmission. A pregnant mother can also pass a disease on to her unborn child.

2. DROPLET



Some diseases are spread by coughing or sneezing, which can cause droplets containing the infectious agent to land on nearby people.

Indirect

Indirect transmission occurs when a disease is passed from an infected person to another person, even though the two people have not had direct contact

3. FECAL-ORAL



Fecal-oral transmission occurs when feces—often microscopic amounts are transmitted from an infected person or animal to another person by mouth. This can happen if food workers use the restroom but do not adequately wash their hands before preparing food for customers to eat.

4. AIRBORNE



Sometimes, an infectious agent enters the air when an infected person sneezes, coughs, laughs or even just breathes—and it can remain in the air for an extended period of time. When another person comes into contact with the agent, this can lead to airborne transmission.

5. FOMITES



A fomite is an inanimate object that serves as a vehicle to pass an infectious disease from an infected person to a healthy person. For example, a water fountain might become contaminated by the saliva of an infected person and pass that disease on to another person who drinks from it. Other examples of potential fomites include doorknobs, handrails, and shared computer keyboards.

Vector

Vector transmission requires another organism to transmit a disease from person to person or from animal to person. This is a type of zoonotic (animal to person) transmission, but differs from direct zoonosis, in which a vertebrate animal contracts a disease and passes it directly to a person, as with rabies

6. INSECT BITE





Vector-borne diseases are most commonly transmitted by insect bites. For example, mosquitoes acquire malaria parasites by feeding on infected humans and then transfer that infection to other people when they feed again. The plague, which killed tens of millions of Europeans in the fourteenth century, was transmitted from rats to humans through flea bites.

Responding to Conspiracy Theories

Social media is rife with conspiracy theories on Covid-19 being manmade. As Muslims, we must believe that any disaster or calamity that befalls us is predestined by Allah The Almighty. Nothing happens without Allah's will. No conspiracy theory nor antichrist nor secret society can harm us except by Allah's will.





"Say, "Never will we be struck except by what Allah has decreed for us; He is our protector." And upon Allah let the believers rely." [At-Taubah : 51]

Instead of entertaining these theories, we should focus our efforts on abiding by the authorities' advice: follow the SOPs and do not expose ourselves or others to any harm, because prevention is always better than cure.

The Sunnah and the Covid-19 SOP

The measures taken by various Governments to prevent the spread of the virus include:

- 1. Closing of mosque and musolla during the epidemic.
- 2. Suspension of mass prayers and Jumaat during the epidemic.
- 3. Distance between prayers in mass prayers during the epidemic.

In Surah Al-Baqarah, verse 239, Allah addressed the manner in which the obligatory prayer can be performed at times of war (walking or riding). This shows that the manner in which an ibadah is performed can change in response to specific situations.

Closing of the mosques and suspending communal prayers or the Jumaat prayer is all about protecting lives from the epidemic. Meanwhile, offering the salah while observing social distancing is the minimum response one can do to uphold the Sunnah of communal prayer instead of leaving it altogether.

PERFORMING YOUR IBADAH DURING SICKNESS

Different rulings for sick person according his/her situations:

Purification:

If the sick person unable to perform cleansing, or ablution, or ghusl by himself/herself, he/ she can be assisted by others.

If any part of the body is covered by a bandage, simply wipe over the covering with damp hands. It is Sunnah to pour some water into your palms before wiping them on the body parts to be washed. This minimises water wastage.

If contact with water aggravates the sickness, then perform tayammum. If the sick person cannot perform the tayammum by himself/ herself, he/she can be assisted by others.

"But if you are ill or on a journey or one of you comes from the place of relieving himself or you have contacted women and do not find water, then seek clean earth and wipe over your faces and hands with it. Allah does not intend to make difficulty for you, but He intends to purify you and complete His favor upon you that you may be grateful." [Al-Maaidah : 6]

Tayammum




The Sunnah way in doing the tayammum is by striking your palm once on clean dirt (dry soil), shaking off the excess, then wiping over your face and the back of your palms (starting with the right).

If clean dust is not readily available, it is permissible to perform tayammum by wiping over the wall, bed sheet or any item covered with dust.

If the sick person can neither perform ablution or tayammum, nor is there anyone to assist him/her, then his prayer will still be sufficient. If the sick person cannot change his impure clothes, or be cleansed of filth (whether from the body, coverings or bed), his prayer will still be sufficient.

Solat/Prayer



The sick person can pray by sitting in whatever position is easy for him/ her, whether crossed legged or with legs outstretched. The ruku' and the sujud are done by leaning the upper part of the body forward, with the sujud to be lower than the ruku'.

When praying by lying on the side, the sick person should lie on the right side of his/her body and, if possible, try to face the qiblah. The ruku' and the sujud are done by signalling with the head, with the inclination of the head during sujud to be lower than the ruku'.


If the sick person can do none of the above, he/she can pray while lying on the back. Look up to the ceiling and pick three points: one to signify the position of qiyaam, the second for ruku' and the third for sujud, in descending order.

Kiblah should be observed always when performing the Salat. But if it is not possible, then the sick person can pray towards any direction easy for him/her. The sick person must also observe the prayer time to the best of his/her ability.

However, if he/she has difficulty to make taharah for every salah, then it is permissible for him to delay the Zohor prayer at the end of its time to the early time of Asar, so they can be performed with one taharah. The same can be done with Maghrib and Isyak prayers.

Fasting

These are the three scenarios of fasting for the sick person:



IF YOUR CONDITION WORSENS & YOU FEEL DEATH IS NEAR

Repent to Allah & ask for forgiveness for your sins and wrongdoings

From the Prophet of Allah (ﷺ), he said: **"Indeed Allah accepts the repentance of a slave as long as (his soul does not reach his throat).**" [Sunan At-Tirmidzi no. 3537]

Apologize to whoever you may have wronged

Abu Huraira reported Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) as saying: "Do you know who is bankrupt?". They (the Companions of the Holy Prophet) said: A bankrupt man amongst us is one who has neither dirham with him nor wealth. He (the Holy Prophet ﷺ) said: "The bankrupt of my Umma would be he who would come on the Day of Resurrection with prayers and fasts and Zakat but (he would find himself bankrupt on that day as he would have exhausted his funds of virtues) since he hurled abuses upon others, brought calumny against others and unlawfully consumed the wealth of others and shed the blood of others and beat others, his virtues would be credited to the account of one (who suffered at his hand). And if his good deeds fall short to clear the account, then his (the other's) sins would be entered in (his account) and he would be thrown in the Hell-Fire."

[Sahih Muslim no. 2581]

Do as many good deeds as you can

Anas ibn Malik reported that the Prophet (ﷺ) said: "If the Final Hour comes while you have a shoot of a plant in your hands and it is possible to plant it before the Hour comes, you should plant it."

[Adab Al-Mufrad no. 479]

Write a will for your beloved ones

Ibn Umar (Allah be pleased with them) reported that Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) said: "**It is the duty of a Muslim who has something which is to be given as a bequest not to have it for two nights without having his will written down regarding it**" [Sahih Muslim no. 1627]

The Will can be about leaving your possessions to those other than your inheritors, settling debts owed to Allah (fasting, zakat or kaffarah) or others, items for safekeeping belonging to someone else, or advice about Iman and Taqwa, etc.

Continue to say لا إله إلا الله [Lā ilāha illallāh]

Narrated by Mu'adh bin Jabal (Allah be pleased with them): The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) as saying: **If anyone's last words are "There is no god but Allah" he will enter Paradise.** [Sahih Muslim no. 1627]





At the Graveyard

Women are not encouraged to attend a burial process. [Sahih Al-Bukhari no. 313 & Sahih Muslim no. 938] If a woman must attend, her attire and manners must comply with the Islamic dressing code.
